The group meets regularly</p> <p>2 No active development of new features requiring extensive schema changes is on-going, but the group continues to be available to address issues and maintain the spec (e.g. add new coding scheme values, correct errors, and new minor tweaks and variations that don't require extensive discussion)</p> <p>3 A group oriented to evaluating an application of the specification and developing implementation guidelines as well as providing feedback to other working groups. User groups do not in general develop new features in the FpML schema. A user group is more likely to be required where FpML users are communicating directly with each other (peer to peer) rather than using a central service offering to perform the functions.</p> <p>4 The group is no longer able to provide a quorum of members and/or a chair to support its area of the standard. New members are not permitted.</p>
